Dear Sirs,

The trust, since its very inception, has been contributing substantially towards the socio-religious needs of the people, irrespective of their faith, cast, creed or colour.

The trust is a well-knit and disciplined organization and with its limited financial resources, the trust is offering community centered services in the fields like medical/health, education and besides in socio-religious discipline. The past few years witnessed remarkable growth and development of the trust as a centre for social changes. It was with a view to catering to the needs of the needy and deserving people that a medical consultation center was set up, attended by a qualified physician and a physiotherapy center reasonably equipped to cater the needs of the common man and attended by a qualified Physiotherapist. In addition to this three free medical/general health camps were organized and conducted last year only. These camps served around three hundred ailing and needy people. We plan to hold several more camps at short intervals for the benefits of the needy.

Educational grants for the deserving are paid on yearly basis.

Medical aid out of medical budget and sahaytakosh is also paid to the deserving/ needy patients diagnosed with serious diseases or those declared physically handicapped.

Over and above this, the trust has raised a reasonably huge complex and a separate Yagashalla, for the solemnization of Yagnopavit ceremony, Hawans, Kahnather and post-death rituals like 10th day, 12th day, Shadmos and Vaherver.


There is a library, housing books on various disciplines and of academic interest.

Problems facing the Trust

Much though we would like to continue to fulfill our socio-religious responsibilities towards the general public that too with more vigor and vitality, there is a big question mark against the realization of this cherished goal of ours. Pressure groups like the Mohalla wallas/Neighbours etc. are hell bent upon creating stumbling blocks, threats, squirmishes, and pressure tactics and violence are being restored to to demoralize the trust workers and clip their wings. The non cooperative and hostile attitude has vitiated the environment around the holy shrine to the point of stifling and crippling the trust members as well as beneficiaries. This trust is for no obvious reasons being discriminated against. It has been singled out for such unwarranted treatment on filthy grounds. A fortnight back, the locals, __on one pretext or the other__ stooped so low as to harass and nearly manhandle the host of the Yagnopavit Ceremony. The ugly scene thus created, forced the trust management to call the police for help and protection. The trust was left with no choice but to succumb to the pressure of law enforcing authority and locals and reluctantly agree to not allowing the use of trust premises for Yagnopavit ceremony. We appeal to our brethren as also every well-meaning individual to kindly come forward to guide and help us as to how best we can prevail upon such hostile groups so that the services offered __ now put on hold__ can be restored to the deserving and needy people at the earliest.
